MATERIALS

- Stretch knit - Wonderful ribbon (optional)

STEPS

REQUIRED MATERIAL


- 4-way stretch knit 1.4 m (55 in) Scissors or rotary knife
 - Wonderful ribbon (optional)



1- Cut two pieces into the knit fabric of your choice.



2- For the neckline and hem, turn twice and stitch in a straight stich. Since the neckline and the hem are loose, they will not be stretched permanently, but you can opt for a stretch point or a zigzag stitch. If you are not very comfortable with the sewing of the stretch knit, you can use the wonderful ribbon to secure all your sides. The fabric will avoid stretching when assembling your poncho.



3- Put your fabric right sides facing each other and stitch both sides to the four thread stitch. If you do not have an overlock, you can make a straight or stretch seam and zigzag stitch for a nice finish.




